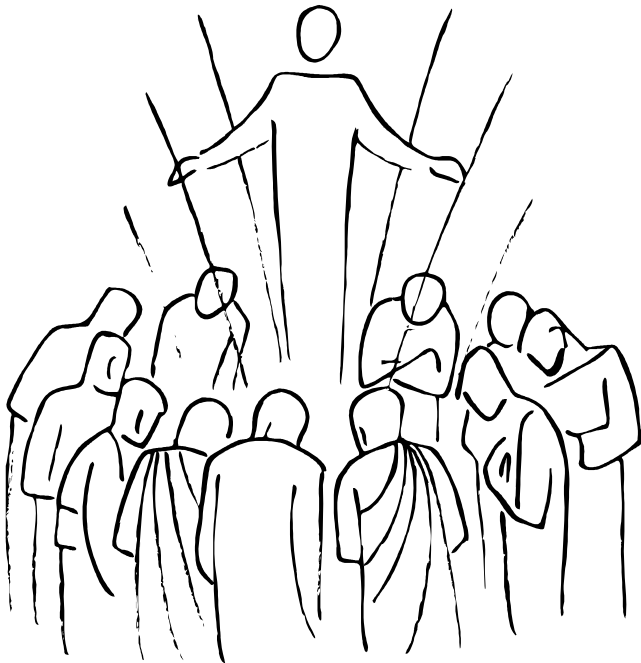

Summary of the Law

Our Lord Jesus Christ said: The first commandment is this: 'Hear O Israel, the Lord our God is the only Lord. There is no other commandment greater than these. On these two commandments hang all the law and the prophets.

Holy Communion

Hear the words of comfort our Saviour Christ says to all
who truly turn to him:

Come to me, all who labour and are heavy laden, and I
will give you rest. *Matthew 11.28*

Hear what Saint Paul says: This saying is true and worthy

advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous;
and he is the propitiation for our sins. *1 John 2.1,2*

Minister: Lift up your hearts

All: We lift them to the Lord

Minister: Let us give thanks to the Lord our God.

All: It is right to give Him thanks and praise.

It is indeed right, it is our duty and our joy, at all times and
in all places to give you thanks and praise, holy Father,
heavenly King, almighty and eternal God. But chiefly are
we bound to praise you because you raised him gloriously
from the dead. For he is the true paschal lamb who was
offered for us, and has taken away the sin of the world. By
his death he has destroyed death, and by his rising to life
again he has restored to us everlasting life.

**Therefore with angels and archangels,
and with all the company of heaven,
we proclaim your great and glorious name,
for ever praising you, and saying
Holy, holy, holy Lord,
God of power and might,
Heaven and earth are full of your glory.
Glory be to you, O Lord most high.**

**We do not presume to come to this your table,
merciful Lord, trusting in our own righteousness,
but in your manifold and great mercies.**

**We are not worthy so much as to gather up the
crumbs under your table.**

**But you are the same Lord
whose nature is always to have mercy.**

**Grant us therefore, gracious Lord,
so to eat the flesh of your dear Son Jesus Christ
and to drink his blood, that our sinful bodies
may be made clean by his body, and our souls
washed through his most precious blood,
and that we may evermore dwell in him
and he in us. Amen.**

Almighty God, our heavenly Father, who in your tender
mercy, gave your only Son our Saviour Jesus Christ to
suffer death upon the cross for our redemption; who made
there by his one oblation of himself once offered a full,
perfect and sufficient sacrifice, oblation and satisfaction
for the sins of the whole world; he instituted, and in his
holy gospel commanded us to continue, a perpetual
memory of his precious death until he comes again.

Hear us, merciful Father, we humbly pray, and grant that
we receiving these gifts of your creation, this bread and
this wine, according to your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ's
holy institution, in remembrance of his death and passion,
may be partakers of his most blessed body and blood;
who, in the same night that he was betrayed, took bread
and gave you thanks; *(the minister takes the paten)* he broke
it and gave it to his disciples, saying: *(the minister breaks
the bread)* Take, eat, this is my body which is given for
you; do this in remembrance of me. In the same way, after
supper, he took the cup; *(he takes the cup)* and when he
had given thanks, he gave it to them, saying: Drink this,
all of you, this is my blood of the new covenant, which is
shed for you and for many for the forgiveness of sins. Do
this, as often as you drink it, in remembrance of me. **Amen.**

The Administration

These words are said at the administration of the bread:

May the body of our Lord Jesus Christ, which was given
for you, preserve your body and soul to everlasting life.
Take and eat this in remembrance that Christ died for
you, and feed on him in your heart by faith with
thanksgiving.

These words are said at the administration of the cup:

May the blood of our Lord Jesus Christ, which was shed
for you, preserve your body and soul to everlasting life.
Drink this in remembrance that Christ's blood was shed
for you, and be thankful.
