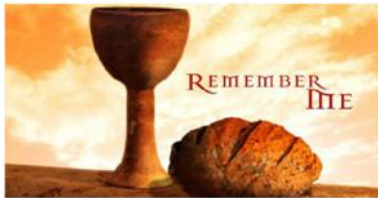
The Administration
