2011 GIFT DAY

20th November

Last year when our budget for 2011 was set, the proceeds of this year's Gift Day were all assigned to help finish the Cornerstone Project. It's great to see the contractors on site this week and that the final interviews for the new Manager take place shortly.

The Cornerstone Group anticipates that we need to raise about £50,000 as a congregation, mainly through this Gift Day, in order to complete the project and pre fund payment for fixtures and fittings and the first year's salary for the Manager/Missioner. Full information will be released on 13th.

Many have already participated and it is enormously encouraging that we are down to almost the last 10% required, out of a total of over £0.4m. Yet this obviously still represents a significant balance to raise.

One way of our facing the challenge is to note that the amount would be covered by 100 donations each of £400 Gift Aided. To some this will be a huge amount; others might be able to provide more, others only consider as a couple or family. We can only contemplate such a total sum if everyone responds as generously as possible, probably even sacrificially. This is our prayer. Please do pray how you might participate on 20th Nov and look out for more detailed information next weekend.
