**Home Groups.** These 12 small, informal groups meet at various times and locations around the parish to relax, learn and pray together. Usually on Wednesday evenings, we meet fortnightly starting 12th, 13th or 14th January (depending on group). All are most welcome and any member of staff would be happy to help you find the right group.

Our central **Parish Prayer and Praise Meetings** take place usually on the first Wednesday of the month - 6th January, 3rd February, 3rd March and 14th April, all at 7:30pm in the Parish Centre. All are welcome to this opportunity to hear, keep up to date, and respond to what's going on and coming up in the life of the church and our mission and ministry partners.

As well as our special **APCM** evening (24th Feb) we also have our **Half Term Holiday Club** (mornings, 15th-19th Feb) and Easter meditations during the evenings of Holy Week (29th-31st March); with Holy Communion on Maundy Thursday (1st April, 7.30 pm)

**"Just Looking"** is an introductory course, aimed at those curious enough to examine the Christian faith. The course involves five, informal, meetings, each starting with a meal followed by a short talk and time for discussion. The next course starts Thursday 14 January - please ask the Parish Office for details and bookings.
